The Asante Centre is currently seeking a pediatrician interested in working as part of a multidisciplinary team (pediatrician, registered psychologist, speech/language pathologist, etc.) for the clinical assessment and neurodiagnosis of children with FASD, autism and complex development and behaviour problems. The Centre provides diagnostic, assessment and family support services to individuals and families impacted by prenatal alcohol and other substance exposures. The Asante Centre for Fetal Alcohol Syndrome is a non-profit agency and governed by the Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) Society for B.C., whose work in Fetal Alcohol Syndrome is known internationally.

The work of the pediatrician would also include participation in education workshops, research activities, policy development, etc. The position is part-time, but there is ample opportunity to join two community pediatricians in a fee-for-service office practice, as well as sharing an "on-call" schedule for Hospital In-patient, Neonatology and Emergency Services through the Fraser Health Authority and Ridge Meadows Hospital.
